Clothing**

- Black Helmet (ATSM/SEI)
- White long sleeved Show Shirt(s) with collar
- Breeches/jodphurs (tan/beige)
- Navy or black show coat
- Black Gloves
- Black Belt
- Boots (polished) / Half chaps
- Socks
- Garters/Jod straps
- Hair nets/clips/pins/rubber bands/bows
- Spurs/spur straps*
- Crop*
- Schooling clothes – polo shirt/ Wyn Farm gear
- Extra boot polish
- Shoes for bathing horse
- Change of clothes

Tack

- Saddle
- Schooling pad(s)
- Show pad(s)
- Schooling front boots
- Bell boots
- Girth
- Martingale*
- Bridle(s)/bit
- Alternate bits/flash noseband*
- Shipping halter (leather)/ leather lead
- No Bows Leg wraps (4) for shipping/ wrapping
- Green standing wraps (4) for shipping/ wrapping

- Saddle soap/oil
- Stud chain*
- Lunge line, whip*

Grooming

- Brush box/brushes
- Hoof pick
- Rag/towel
- Fly spray**
- Showsheen**
- Shampoo & Conditioner**
- Wash bucket/wash supplies**
- Sponge/sweatscraper**
- Liniment**

Feed

- Hay/Hay bag - 1 bale per show day per horse
- Horse Treats/Carrots **
- Feed/Supplement bags (AM and PM per show day)

Miscellaneous

- 3-4 bags shavings per 2 day show**
- Duct/masking tape
- Show sheet, anti-sweat sheet*
- Cooler, blanket*
- Sunscreen**
- Cash for food/drinks**
- Bottled water/drinks/snacks**
- Tack Trunk or Large Rubbermaid-type bin for your equipment**

Most Wyn Farm horses/ponies "own" their own equipment. It is available for you to use, however, you are responsible for getting it together and ready, cleaning before and after use, and putting it away in it's proper place when done. If items are broken or damaged while in your care, you are expected to repair or replace them.

Because many students purchase the EXACT same type of riding equipment, please be sure to mark it with your name to avoid mix-ups!

** items denoted with double asterisk are to be supplied by rider, otherwise fees may apply
